



Editor's Note: Following his return from seven years' exile, King Nebuchadnezzar sat down with the Daily Triumph for this exclusive interview.

DT: Your majesty, it's good to see you. How are you feeling, now that you're back in the palace after such a long time?

KN: You know, it just feels great to be back on the throne...issuing edicts, hosting banquets, seeing my every command carried out. Yeah, awesome.

KN: Look, try spending seven years in the wilderness,

DT: (Ahem) Yes, your majesty, very nice. What about your state of mind during that time? Were you aware that there were concerns for your...with all due respect...your sanity?

KN: Of course I heard that. It probably had something to do with my diet at that time. I went vegan, developed a yen for grass. It's delicious!

DT: I see. Can you tell us how you returned to your...er, how the situation changed for you?

KN: Well, it's like I sort of woke up. I realized I had kind of freaked out and it was time to be kingly again. I began thinking about the Most High God—once I realized he had humbled me for my own good, I started praising him and feeling more like my old self again. God restored me. He is powerful! Bottom line: the King of Babylon now honors the King of Heaven.

DT: Thank you, your majesty.

DANIEL 4:1-18 (NIV) CONT.

³How great are his signs, how mighty his wonders! His kingdom is an eternal kingdom; his dominion endures from generation to generation.

⁴I, Nebuchadnezzar, was at home in my palace, contented and prosperous. ⁵I had a dream that made me afraid. As I was lying in bed, the images and visions that passed through my mind terrified me. ⁶So I commanded that all the wise men of Babylon be brought before me to interpret the dream for me. ⁷When the magicians, enchanters, astrologers and diviners came, I told them the dream, but they could not interpret it for me. ⁸Finally, Daniel came into my presence

and I told him the dream. (He is called Belteshazzar, after the name of my god, and the spirit of the holy gods is in him.)

⁹I said, "Belteshazzar, chief of the magicians, I know that the spirit of the holy gods is in you, and no mystery is too difficult for you. Here is my dream; interpret it for me. ¹⁰These are the visions I saw while lying in bed: I looked, and there before me stood a tree in the middle of the land. Its height was enormous. ¹¹The tree grew large and strong and its top touched the sky; it was visible to the ends of the earth. ¹²Its leaves were beautiful, its fruit abundant, and on it was food for all. Under it the wild animals

found shelter, and the birds lived in its branches; from it every creature was fed.

¹³"In the visions I saw while lying in bed, I looked, and there before me was a holy one, a messenger, coming down from heaven. ¹⁴He called in a loud voice: "Cut down the tree and trim off its branches; strip off its leaves and scatter its fruit. Let the animals flee from under it and the birds from its branches. ¹⁵But let the stump and its roots, bound with iron and bronze, remain in the ground, in the grass of the field.

"Let him be drenched with the dew of heaven, and let him live with the animals among the plants of the earth. ¹⁶Let his mind be changed from that of a

man and let him be given the mind of an animal, till seven times pass by for him.

¹⁷"The decision is announced by messengers, the holy ones declare the verdict, so that the living may know that the Most High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes and sets over them the lowliest of people."

¹⁸"This is the dream that I, King Nebuchadnezzar, had. Now, Belteshazzar, tell me what it means, for none of the wise men in my kingdom can interpret it for me. But you can, because the spirit of the holy gods is in you."



THE JOY OF SERVING

There are some things that can only be taught by experience.

Julie and Ted Croy knew that what they had experienced as new believers on the mission field was something they wanted to pass down to their children. But it would be years before they would be able to do that.

Julie was a new believer when she went to Ghana for the first time. The experience affected her so much she encouraged her husband to go on a short-term trip himself. Back then, going as a family was out of the question since their three children were all younger than five.

“It took a lot of faith to just go, but we did,” Julie said. And the experiences changed the course of their family’s story.

For years, they waited patiently until the opportunity for the family of five to go on a short-term mission trip together arose.

That opportunity came through the Manos de Cristo project in 2014.

“God laid it on our hearts that it was time to go. We began praying where God would send us and after a missions potluck at Oak Hills, we knew that we were going to Nicaragua,” Julie said.

The Croys were drawn to the Manos de Cristo project because of its timing – near Christmas – and because they knew they would meet those they were serving. Their children not only chose what they would put in the Manos de Cristos gift boxes, but also prayed over them and hand delivered them to the kids who benefited from them.


“This was really an awesome thing just to be able to experience that, to watch our kids embrace children from another culture,” Julie said.

That trip laid the groundwork for their oldest daughter Kaytlyn to go and serve on her own – she went to Haiti last fall on another mission trip with a group from Oak Hills. Julie says Kaytlyn’s trip was something that served as a reminder of the triumphs that come from teaching what it means to serve.

“This helped us to know that God has been triumphant in our lives and has allowed us to find Him and try to change the next generation,” she said. “We know there are more victories ahead, but we’re hoping we’ve given them a good foundation.”
