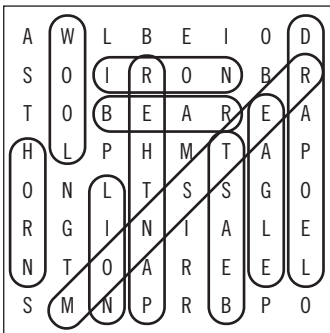

OF FOUR BEASTS

DANIEL 7:1-14 (NIV)

¹In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon, Daniel had a dream, and visions passed through his mind as he was lying in bed. He wrote down the substance of his dream.

²Daniel said: "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me were the four winds of heaven churning up the great sea. ³Four great beasts, each different from the others, came up out of the sea.

⁴"The first was like a lion, and it had the wings of an eagle. I watched until its wings were torn off and it was lifted from the ground so that it stood on two feet like a human being,

and the mind of a human was given to it.

⁵"And there before me was a second beast, which looked like a bear. It was raised up on one of its sides, and it had three ribs in its mouth between its teeth. It was told, 'Get up and eat your fill of flesh!'

⁶"After that, I looked, and there before me was another beast, one that looked like a leopard. And on its back it had four wings like those of a bird. This beast had four heads, and it was given authority to rule.

⁷"After that, in my vision at

night I looked, and there before me was a fourth beast—terrifying and frightening and very powerful. It had large iron teeth; it crushed and devoured its victims and trampled underfoot whatever was left. It was different from all the former beasts, and it had ten horns.

⁸"While I was thinking about the horns, there before me was another horn, a little one, which came up among them; and three of the first horns were uprooted before it. This horn had eyes like the eyes of a human being and a mouth that spoke boastfully.

⁹"As I looked, "thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His clothing was as white as snow; the hair of his head was white like wool. His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. ¹⁰A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him. Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him. The court was seated, and the books were opened.

¹¹"Then I continued to watch because of the boastful words the horn was speaking. I kept looking until the beast was slain and its body destroyed and thrown into the blazing fire. ¹²(The other beasts had been stripped of their authority, but were allowed to live for a period of time.)

¹³"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man,[a] coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. ¹⁴He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed.

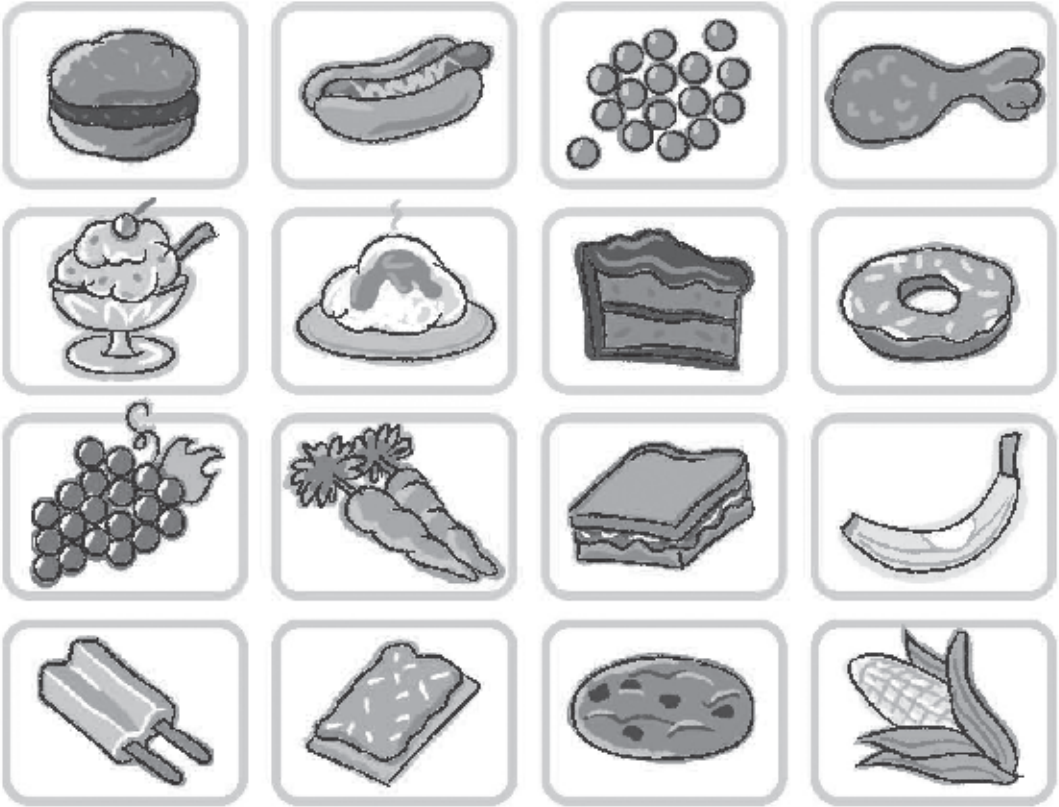

SERVING WITH A SMILE

It’s been 12 years since Tom Watkins first heard about the possibility of going to Guatemala on a mission trip. A patient and friend from Oak Hills had suggested he pray about going, but it wasn’t something he had ever thought about doing up until that point. Nerves had kept Tom, a dentist, from taking the leap right away.

“I wasn’t really sure about it,” Tom said. “He kept saying ‘you need to prayerfully consider it.’ Finally, I decided, ‘I’m going to do this.’”

Soon enough Tom was on his way to Guatemala with a group from Oak Hills. That trip was the beginning of something that went beyond anything Tom had ever imagined.

He used his skills as a dentist to help those who couldn’t otherwise get dental work done. He’s gone every year since.

“The first time I went was like an epiphany to me. That first trip was just an amazing event for me. It really did change my life in a big way,” Tom said.

From the work that he did on patients to – especially – the relationships he created, Tom realized that serving others is what he was meant to do.

“There was a boy who lives on the streets that over the years I’ve developed this relationship with,” Tom said. “Every year I go down there and he’s always waiting on the steps for me. He’s a real special kid to me.”

But that isn’t the end of the story.

Tom decided that this mission trip experience he had should make its way here – right back to San Antonio.

After that trip, he recruited some of his staff to join him on these mission trips. But he wanted everyone he works with to experience what he had: the joy of serving others.

“One of our core values is to serve,” Tom said about his dental practice. “I work with some very special people. Everybody that is in our organization, they like helping others, too.”

So Tom did exactly what he did in Guatemala – he opened his heart and door to those less fortunate and held a free clinic in San Antonio, offering free dental services. The event is called Dentistry from the Heart and happens every November.

“It was an opportunity for me to give everybody in the office a feel for mission dentistry,” Tom said. “But we’re doing it for people here in our hometown.”

For Tom, it was a way to give back to both the less fortunate and the staff that works for him.

Everybody in the office got to have that feeling – that excitement you get when you serve people. It’s one of the most tiring and exhausting days but one of the most fun days to come in to work.”

To say the event has been a

success would be an understatement.

“The first one that we did, we saw maybe 70 or 80 people that came that day,” Tom said. “We had 260 patients during the one we just finished in November last year. There were people who had been camping out overnight. It was pretty astounding. It was amazing. I just couldn’t believe the numbers of people that responded. It was just a great.”

During the Dentistry from the Heart event, patients have the option of getting a free clean-

ing, extraction or filling.

“For me, it’s been a great experience, both going to Guatemala and doing Dentistry from the Heart,” Tom said. “I’ll keep going to Guatemala as long as I can and try to keep taking people when I can.

“The only way I can describe that experience when you walk away from serving like this, especially that first time you’ve gone, is that it’s what the Holy Spirit feels like inside of you, exuding out from you.”

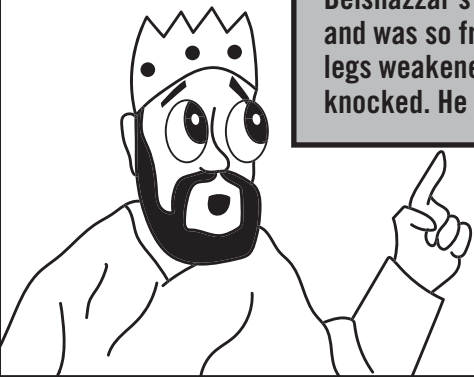
Belshazzar held a banquet with his wives, concubines, and nobles. They used goblets from the temple in Jerusalem and praised their gods.



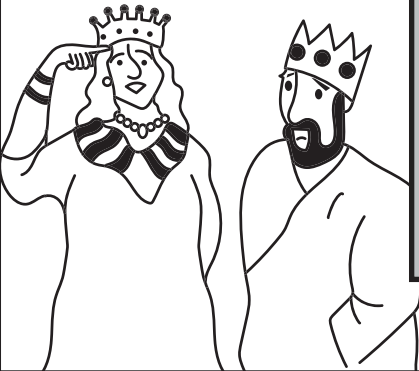
Suddenly, during the party, a hand appeared writing on the wall.
