

RUMORS OF WAR CAUSE PANIC

KINGS OF THE SOUTH AND THE NORTH

SCRIPTURE

DANIEL 11:1-35 (NIV)

¹And in the first year of Darius the Mede, I took my stand to support and protect him.)

²“Now then, I tell you the truth: Three more kings will arise in Persia, and then a fourth, who will be far richer than all the others. When he has gained power by his wealth, he will stir up everyone against the kingdom of Greece. ³Then a mighty king will arise, who will rule with great power and do as he pleases. ⁴After he has arisen, his empire will be broken up and parceled out toward the four winds of heaven. It will not go to his descendants, nor will it have the power he exercised, because his empire will be uprooted and given to others.

⁵“The king of the South will become strong, but one of his commanders will become even stronger than he and will rule his own kingdom with great power. ⁶After some years, they will become allies. The daughter of the king of the South will go to the king of the North to make an alliance, but she will not retain her power, and he and his power will not last. In those days she will be betrayed, together with her royal escort and her father and the one who supported her. (see page 2)

Panic spread through the kingdom yesterday as rumors of wars between kingdoms emerged. No confirmation has been given as to the precise timing of these wars, but citizens are encouraged to stand ready.

News of this anticipated global conflict came from the King's official, Daniel, following another revelation by the angel Michael. Details are still reverberating throughout the city and countryside.

According to Michael, a rich and powerful king will dominate, as four regions emerge. Information is still coming forth, but as of today, this is what we know:

Following the split of the four parts to this kingdom, the king of the Southern part of the empire will be strong, but not for long. His commander will take over and become allies with the North, but at the expense of his daughter, who will be given in exchange. That power won't last for long.

An unnamed person (from within her own family) will begin fighting against the North again.

Battles between the North and the South will continue for years, creating leaders only out

to exalt themselves. The anonymous source describes at least one of these as contemptible. And even when those in the kingdoms feel they are safe, they are anything but, the warnings say. Armies will fall, fortresses will be overthrown.

Those who know God will resist many of the abhorrent things happening around them, but sadly will die by the sword, be burned, captured, or plundered.

What is perhaps the most shocking revelation is the rise of the king who denies even the one true God's existence. Nobody will know what to do with him.

Along with these anticipated wars and cruelties, Edom, Moab and the leaders of Ammon will be spared. Although this king will eventually die, irrevocable damage will have been done.

KINGS OF THE SOUTH AND THE NORTH

DANIEL 11:1-35 (NIV) CONT.

⁷ “One from her family line will arise to take her place. He will attack the forces of the king of the North and enter his fortress; he will fight against them and be victorious. ⁸He will also seize their gods, their metal images and their valuable articles of silver and gold and carry them off to Egypt. For some years he will leave the king of the North alone. ⁹Then the king of the North will invade the realm of the king of the South but will retreat to his own country. ¹⁰His sons will prepare for war and assemble a great army, which will sweep on like an irresistible flood and carry the battle as far as his fortress.

¹¹ “Then the king of the South will march out in a rage and fight against the king of the North, who will raise a large army, but it will be defeated. ¹²When the army is carried off, the king of the South will be filled with pride and will slaughter many thousands, yet he will not remain triumphant. ¹³For the king of the North will muster another army, larger than the first; and after several years, he will advance with a huge army fully equipped.

¹⁴ “In those times many will rise against the king of the South. Those who are violent among your own people will rebel in fulfillment of the vision, but without success. ¹⁵Then the king of the North will come and build up siege ramps and will capture a fortified city. The forces of the South will be powerless to resist; even their best troops will not have the strength to stand. ¹⁶The invader will do as he pleases; no one will be able to stand against him. He will

establish himself in the Beautiful Land and will have the power to destroy it. ¹⁷He will determine to come with the might of his entire kingdom and will make an alliance with the king of the South. And he will give him a daughter in marriage in order to overthrow the kingdom, but his plans will not succeed or help him. ¹⁸Then he will turn his attention to the coastlands and will take many of them, but a commander will put an end to his insolence and will turn his insolence back on him. ¹⁹After this, he will turn back toward the fortresses of his own country but will stumble and fall, to be seen no more.

²⁰ “His successor will send out a tax collector to maintain the royal splendor. In a few years, however, he will be destroyed, yet not in anger or in battle.

²¹ “He will be succeeded by a contemptible person who has not been given the honor of royalty. He will invade the kingdom when its people feel secure, and he will seize it through intrigue. ²²Then an overwhelming army will be swept away before him; both it and a prince of the covenant will be destroyed. ²³After coming to an agreement with him, he will act deceitfully, and with only a few people he will rise to power. ²⁴When the richest provinces feel secure, he will invade them and will achieve what neither his fathers nor his forefathers did. He will distribute plunder, loot and wealth among his followers. He will plot the overthrow of fortresses—but only for a time.

²⁵ “With a large army he will stir up his strength and courage against the king of the South. The king of the

South will wage war with a large and very powerful army, but he will not be able to stand because of the plots devised against him. ²⁶Those who eat from the king’s provisions will try to destroy him; his army will be swept away, and many will fall in battle. ²⁷The two kings, with their hearts bent on evil, will sit at the same table and lie to each other, but to no avail, because an end will still come at the appointed time. ²⁸The king of the North will return to his own country with great wealth, but his heart will be set against the holy covenant. He will take action against it and then return to his own country.

²⁹ “At the appointed time he will invade the South again, but this time the outcome will be different from what it was before. ³⁰Ships of the western coastlands will oppose him, and he will lose heart. Then he will turn back and vent his fury against the holy covenant. He

will return and show favor to those who forsake the holy covenant.

³¹ “His armed forces will rise up to desecrate the temple fortress and will abolish the daily sacrifice. Then they will set up the abomination that causes desolation. ³²With flattery he will corrupt those who have violated the covenant, but the people who know their God will firmly resist him.

³³ “Those who are wise will instruct many, though for a time they will fall by the sword or be burned or captured or plundered. ³⁴When they fall, they will receive a little help, and many who are not sincere will join them. ³⁵Some of the wise will stumble, so that they may be refined, purified and made spotless until the time of the end, for it will still come at the appointed time.



BEGIN IN PRAYER

How to get started...

BEGIN IN PRAYER
 This is where it starts. Ask God to pray for the people in the area you've gathered. Pray for your car, ask God to give you wisdom to talk to the people in your neighborhood, and to help you see their needs.

 Use the provided information to find the names, occupations, houses, and details of your neighbors. It starts with names. Don't forget to write the name of the dog, cat, or other pet, too.

ENGAGE IN CONVERSATIONS
 Casual conversations will allow you to build a relational bridge. You are not called to evangelize; you are called to love your neighbor.

SEEK TO BE INTENTIONAL
 Set the date in the next week, and set the time and place. Set the date, time, and place. Use the provided information to find the names, occupations, houses, and details of your neighbors.

SHARE YOUR STORIES
 Learn the story of your neighbor and share yours. Where did you grow up? What is your favorite food? What is your dream? Share your "story" with them.

FROM NEIGHBORS TO FRIENDS

Alice Kolb knew that even if her house was isolated out in the country, she didn't want to be.

Alice, who lives several miles outside of Fredericksburg, is the leader of a group that calls themselves the "Girlfriend Group." The group meets monthly.

"There's no reason for these

women to be connected," Alice said of the group. "They're not connected through church or relationships. It's just...their fence line touches the next fence line and they feel an allegiance to each other."

The group started after Alice, who describes herself as a 71-year-old who has always preferred the city life, decided

she didn't want to feel isolated anymore. So she "knocked on the next mailbox" and started inviting families in the area over for dinner.

"I just put together an invitation and invited people we didn't know at all. We knew their name, but we didn't know them," she said.

What happened next wasn't just a nice time, but the beginning of a tradition that lives on eight years later.

Alice says that at the end of that dinner, she asked the other women in the group if anyone else felt lonely like she did.

"We found out we kind of liked each other," she said. "All of the women that were standing there said yes."

Since then, the group has grown to include 17 women and meets with no agenda at all – except to enjoy each other's company.


"It's really just the sweetest, nicest, most genuine thing I've ever been involved in," Alice said.

She says the beauty of the group is that women from all walks of life come together to care for each other.

"It has been a very rewarding experience," Alice said. "One woman's husband had cancer last year. So I had the opportunity to be involved with that situation. As a Christian I want to do that as a ministry. I want her to know her life makes a difference."
